

Laser Engraver @ The HUB

Use The HUB's laser engraver to engrave images or precision cut shapes with a variety of materials!

Equipment used: Epilog Laser Mini 24, 50 watt

Software used: CorelDRAW

Materials: See Page 2 for approved materials.

• Maximum Dimensions: 24" wide x 12" high x 8" deep

 You can purchase 1/8" thick craft wood or acrylic at The HUB or bring in your own material. We recommend bringing in extra, as quality is not guaranteed.

Tips for Selecting an Image

Save the image, shape, or photo you'd like to engrave or cut onto a flash drive, or attach it to an email to yourself, so that you can access it on a computer in the Makerspace.

- File format: Most image file types are supported (.JPEG., .PNG, .SVG preferred)
- How to get the best results:
 - Engraving
 - High resolution
 - High contrast
 - Photographs may require some editing
 - A "line drawing" effect works best
 - Assistance editing photos may be available upon request
 - Cutting
 - Solid shapes with clear borders
- **Round objects:** The HUB's laser engraver can be used on round objects up to 5" in diameter. (NOTE: Avoid objects with handles, as they will not be able to rotate properly.)
